

Accreditation

The one-credit-per-hour Group Learning Program meets the certification criteria of the College of Family Physicians of Canada and has been certified by the Continuing Professional Development Office of Dalhousie University for up to 6.75 Mainpro+ credits for the ACOG Symposium (June 21-22, 2024) and 2.5 Mainpro+ credits for the CAGPO meeting (June 21, 2024).

As an accredited provider, Dalhousie University Continuing Professional Development and Medical Education, designates this continuing professional development activity for up to 9.25 credit hours as an accredited group learning Section 1 activity as defined by the Maintenance of Certification Program of the Royal College of Physicians and Surgeons of Canada.
